Reason for Visit

1. Communication drop out; power cycling did not re-activate the 3G modem

Observations

- 1. The UPS was off; running theory is a ship crew member turned it off due to loud alarms when battery about to fail
- 2. After power up, it was discovered files last recorded August 30
- 3. Water in Seachest minimal; determined source is not leak but condensation
- 4. Black "dusting" in tubing and in the Seabird cell; likely source is surface coal from Westshore Terminals
- 5. MET station has soot on the temperature and humidity sensor housing, and the barometric pressure housing; likely source is the smoke stack on the ship

Actions Taken

- 1. Checked AC from ship; turned on UPS
- 2. Checked all devices operational and that data from instruments valid and complete
- 3. Confirmed 3G linkage active and checked Jaklyn could connect to the system
- 4. Called Rogers rep to query router settings
- Called John Dorocicz to discuss UPS behaviour; removed UPS cable between Seakeeper computer and UPS
- 6. Created sign for UPS to alert crew to not power off UPS

Future Actions

- 1. Disable Wimax on the router (make 3G default)
- 2. Contact QofA chief engineer to enquire about possibility crew member shut off UPS due to alarms, and why power mains to VENUS may have been shut off on August 30
