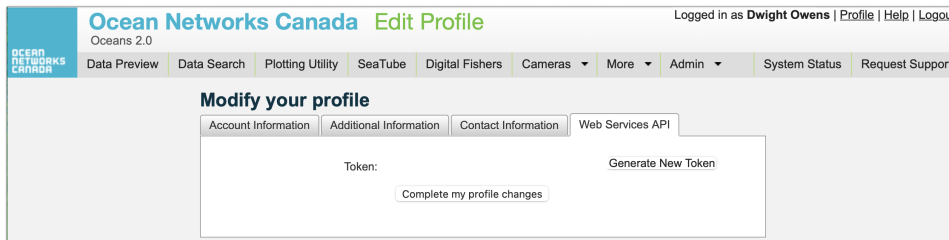


Get your API token

All Web Services provided by the Oceans 3.0 API require a token, as indicated by "*token=YOUR_TOKEN_HERE*" in the [API Reference Guide](#).

Step-by-step guide

1. Log in to Oceans 3.0 via <https://data.oceannetworks.ca/login>
2. Click *Profile* in the upper-right corner of the screen (or visit <https://data.oceannetworks.ca/Profile>)
3. Go to the *Web Services API* tab:
